### Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL)

#### Graduate Certificate Requirements

18 Graduate Credit Hours

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#### Phase I: Graduate Certificate in Teaching for TESL Education

The Graduate Certificate in Teaching is an initial licensure program. Upon completion of Phase I, the Graduate Certificate in Teaching, candidates may choose to apply all their coursework to the optional Phase II Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) (see below).

Final course in this phase: <b>TESL 6470: Internship in Teaching English as a Second Language (3)*</b> *TESL 6470 is a full-time internship requiring employment as an English as a Second Language teacher in an approved school or a non-paid placement with a licensed ESL teacher in a public school. It requires a formal application and approval during the semester prior to the internship.		

### Optional PHASE 2: Masters in Arts in Teaching (MAT)

#### 12 Credit Hours

Prerequisite: To begin Phase II, candidates must complete Phase I, the Graduate Certificate in Teaching (see above), and apply to the Graduate School. Admission to the Graduate Certificate program does not indicate admission to the MAT. Upon completion of Phase II MAT, candidates can apply for an Advanced Level (M-level) license.
